As with the transmission of any communicable disease like a cold or flu, you may be exposed to COVID-19, also known as the “Coronavirus,” at any time or in any place. Be assured that we have always followed state and federal regulations and recommended universal personal protection, infection protocols and have installed air filtration units throughout our office to limit transmission of all diseases in our office and will continue to enhance safety protocols as mandated by the CDC and the Illinois Dept. of Public Health.

Despite our careful attention to sterilization, disinfection, use of personal barriers and sophisticated air filtration systems, there is still a chance that you could be exposed to an illness in our office, just as you might be at your gym, grocery store, or favorite restaurant. “Social Distancing” nationwide has reduced the transmission of the Coronavirus.
